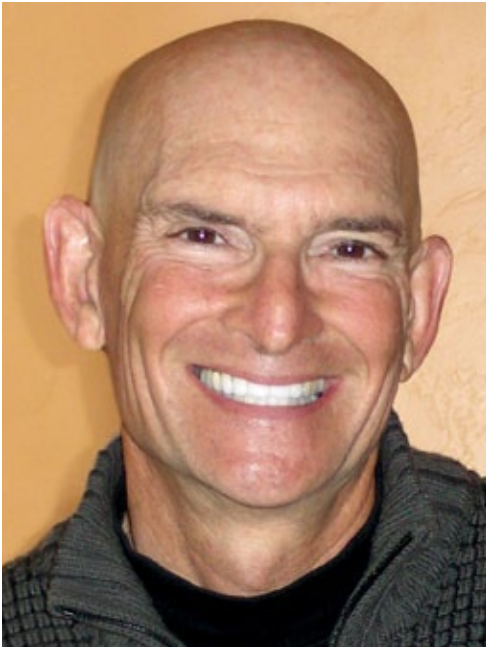
LIFE SKILLS FOR LIFELONG SUCCESS
